# ALBAMAR, XURXO ALBA – RIAS BAIXAS, SPAIN ALBAMAR, XURXO ALBA – RIAS BAIXAS, SPAIN

When we find a winemaker like Xurxo Alba it makes us very excited, and hopefully when you taste his wines you'll understand why. Located at the mouth of the River Umia in Rias Baixas, the maritime influence (the '-mar' part of Albamar) permeates the wines in a way that adds to the tension and precision with a saline minerality that we can't get enough of. Not a one trick pony, Xurxo again shows his ability to create unique and exciting wines with 'Albino', a white made from red grapes that has an almost electric quality, and 'O Esteiro', a light red that is precise and gastronomic.

## **'Albamar' 2020 – Albariño**

The flagship Albariño and the wine that started it all for Xurxo. Texture and tension all day long.

## **'Arrobas 69' 2018 – Albariño**

The result of a collaboration with a local restaurant to make the best example of Albariño possible, and I don't think they're far off. Absolutely stunning.

## **'Albino' 2019 – Caíño Tinto**

A Blanc de Noirs made from very old vine Caíño Tinto. Incredible minerality with just enough perfumed red fruit, this is one of my favourite wines.

## **'O Esteiro' 2016 – Espadeiro, Mencía, Caíño Tinto**

A light red made with grapes from a multitude of plots. Its freshness and purity are reminiscent of some Jura reds, and like their mountainous French counterparts this is an excellent companion to food.

# ALIGOTÉ

Often referred to as the 'third grape' of Burgundy, Aligoté has certainly fallen out of fashion in recent times to the much more prevalent Chardonnay. But in the hands of the right winemaker, this grape can have just as much body, complexity and deliciousness as its more famous counterpart, and is often much better value as well.

# PIERRE-YVES COLIN-MOREY

Once a rising star of the new wave of Burgundy wine makers, Pierre-Yves has solidified his spot at the top with year after year of excellent releases. With c. 10 hectares of owned and rented vines spread across the most famous villages in the Cote d'Or, each wine is a master class in thoughtful and respectful winemaking that allows the individual terroirs to shine through. His use of 350l barrels (instead of the more common 228l) and careful limited use of new oak give his range a consistency and depth that puts his name among the great wine makers of the current generation.

From a sunnier and more south facing slope than the near by Corton-Charlemagne vineyard. 10% new oak	
<b>Chassagne Montrachet 'Vieilles Vignes' 2018</b>	152
From 65 year old vines across 4 parcels on the Puligny side of Chassagne. 16 months in barrel, 3 months in stainless steel. 25% new oak	
<b>Meursault 2018</b>	157
Comprises of fruit from Narvaux (90%) and from Virueils (10%). 16 months in barrel, 3 months in stainless steel. 25% new oak.	
<b>Meursault 'Les Narvaux' 2017</b>	174
45 year old vines. 16 months in barrel, 25% new oak. Rich and buttery balanced with citrus and striking minerality.	
<b>Chassagne Montrachet 1er Cru Chenevottes 2018</b>	214
From north of the village right beside the Grand Cru vineyards.	

# CHABLIS

Whether from 14th generation wine maker Benoît Droin, or 1st generation Quebec native Patrick Piuze, the unmistakable steely and mineral character of Chablis is what brings us back to this region again and again. The cool climate allows for less fruit and more texture and freshness, making these wines the perfect accompaniment to any seafood.
